
Required ActiveX Settings to enable downloading MCPD data

The download capabilities of the MCPD webpage leverage ActiveX controls. To enable these controls will require your browser security settings to match or exceed those described here. The example shown below is specific to Internet Explorer but similar settings can be made in other browsers as well.

- 1. From the Internet Explorer menu, click Tools—Internet options.
- 2. Navigate to the Security tab. While your screen may look different than that shown below, by the time we are finished it will look nearly identical.



- 3. Click the Custom level... button.
- 4. Scroll down to ActiveX controls and plug-ins
 - a. Allow ActiveX Filtering (enabled)
 - b. Allow previously unused ActiveX controls to run without prompt (disable)
 - c. Allow scriptlets (prompt)
 - d. Automatic prompting for ActiveX controls (enable)
 - e. Binary and script behaviors (enable)
 - f. Display video and animation on a webpage.... (disable)
 - g. Download signed ActiveX controls (prompt)
 - h. Download unsigned ActiveX controls (prompt)
 - i. Initialize and script ActiveX controls not marked... (prompt)
 - j. Only allow approved domains.... (disable)
 - k. Run ActiveX controls and plug-ins (enable)
 - I. Script ActiveX controls marked safe for scripting* (enable)
- 5. Click OK
- 6. You will likely need to re-start your computer for these changes to take effect.
