As some of you may know, we are very involved in lidar for Idaho here at Idaho State University's GIS TReC. We have worked with and continue to work with the Idaho Lidar Consortium (ILC) to bring lidar data to the GIS community of Idaho. Today, I would like to let you know about some exciting lidar events happening right now.

The GIS TReC@ISU continues to host both raw (las) and processed Lidar data, delivering all these data as quickly as possible using Globus Online large file transfer. This is a collaboration with the ILC (https://www.idaholidar.org/). The GIS TReC also provides a Lidar image service (Esri REST service).

In addition, through the support of FEMA we will be able to improve data discovery and download with the releasing of our new Idaho Lidar Web Viewer in the next month. We are planning a demo and discussion at the next Elevation TWG!
