We continue to fill the state of Idaho with lidar data, at least from a GIS perspective that is. The last of the Southern Idaho 2018 collections have been reviewed and posted to our servers and are ready for download. Visit <https://www.idaholidar.org/> to access these data.

We are also working toward a comprehensive revision of all bare earth DTM data for Idaho by returning to our own servers and making sure all project areas have DTM data available. Once this is completed (this should be early in July) we will refresh our lidar image service with these data. The result will be better performance with better data.

I will also post the Boise 2003 project that remained under our radar for 21 years. Josh at the ILC recently found this and brought it to my attention. Better late than never, eh?

Lastly, I am currently planning another series of Lidar workshops and if you would like to suggest some dates for these workshops just let me know.
