Hello GIS'ers,

We have lots of good news to share with you this month. So much that I don't know where to start! But let me just lay it out in no particular order.

- 1. Our Idaho Lidar image service became part of the Esri Living Atlas. Check it out at https://livingatlas.arcgis. com/en/browse/?q=lidar#d=2&q=lidar
- 2. We now have approximately 40% of Idaho covered by Lidar. This includes the large Southern Idaho 2018 #6 project area I told you about in last month's report.
- 3. Just last week we received additional Southern Idaho 2018 project areas (#9 and #10 in eastern Idaho) and these are being reviewed, prepared, and copied to our server right now. The Idaho Lidar Web Viewer will be updated as soon as possible to make accessing these data simple.
