We continue to make progress with lidar data for Idaho. Since my last email we have received and uploaded eastern Caribou county data to our servers. If you take a look at the Idaho Lidar Web Viewer (https://isu.maps.arcgis.com/apps/instant/media/index.html?appid=796225ca9c9f4c07a1288225ed1afd30)you will see the state is nearly covered by Lidar. I am hoping early in 2026 we will receive the last pieces to this puzzle and will finally have the state completed.

In addition to posting the new data to our servers for download, we also have updated our DTM image service and DSM image service as well. Using these services means you do not have to download any lidar data to your PC.
