Hello,

I am happy to report that a new lidar project area is currently being prepared at ISU's GIS TReC. This area was provided to us by Idaho Fish & Game and it covers the Sterling WMA just north of American Falls Reservoir. I anticipate these data will be available on our lidar server shortly after the Thanksgiving holiday.

We have also identified several older lidar project areas that currently show on lidar point cloud data (raw data) but do not have any processed rasters. We are processing areas like Pocatello2005 and a handful of others. These data should also be available on our server shortly after the Thanksgiving holiday.

We are expecting a large amount of lidar data will become available from the 2019 FEMA project in December. Once we have these data, we will make these a priority and have them available to you as quickly as possible.

Last, our Lidar image service is moving forward to being recognized as the authoritative TIM (The Idaho Map) elevation dataset. I hope this process will be completed early in the new year. Watch for updates on this in future Idaho Lidar News emails.
