Hello

Like many of you, we are anxiously awaiting the delivery of the lidar data which was collected in 2019 and 2020 for much of southern Idaho. We have been informed that progress is being made on these data and are hopeful we will start seeing these data yet in 2021.

We are also working to acquire lidar that was collected previously and the north Idaho, IDL collection from 2019 is now fully available through the Idaho Lidar Web Viewer. This is a very large dataset also so we have broken it down into 11 manageable folders as indicated in [this PDF \(https://giscenter.isu.edu/files/IDL_2019_TileReference.pdf\)](https://giscenter.isu.edu/files/IDL_2019_TileReference.pdf)
