Hello,

Last week we received a drive with over 4TB of new lidar data for Idaho. Specifically, the **North Fork Payette 2020** project which is now live and available for download on our lidar servers. This project is approximately 1 million acres of QL1 data! (we chopped it into manageable chunks to make the process easier for you).

We also posted the raw LAS files (we did not have the LAS files previously) for the **Blackfoot Portneuf 2018** project. These data are also available.

We are currently running a pitfill on these new data and will add the bare earth layer to our streaming image service as soon as possible.
