We have been very busy here at ISU's GIS TReC processing and re-processing various lidar projects to improve the data and services offered to you. Here is what's new:

- A new streaming web image service is available that offers faster performance over the web.
- The "IDL 2019" project LAS files have been reviewed and re-processed to include more ground based classifications, our automated re-processing added over 3 billion new ground returns.
- The "IDL 2019" project now has bare earth raster products available that have been pit-filled to enable improved flow modeling.
- The "Payette Basin 2019" project is now available with smaller download packages and an easy to use file index map (PDF)
- I will be teaching the "Working with Lidar in ArcGIS Pro" and "Lidar Applications and Spatial Analysis with ArcGIS Pro" workshops on January 13-14, 2022. A few seats remain for each of these full-day workshops which are FREE. For more details visit <https://giscenter.isu.edu/Workshops/index.htm>

We are expecting delivery of new lidar data late in January 2022. As soon as these new data become available we will process them and make them available to you!
