As you may recall, we are very involved in lidar for Idaho here at Idaho State University's GIS TReC. We have worked with and continue to work with the Idaho Lidar Consortium (ILC) to bring lidar data to the GIS community of Idaho.

Today, I would like to let you know about some lidar events and news happening right now.

The GIS TReC@ISU continues to host both raw (las) and processed Lidar data, delivering all these data as quickly as possible using Globus Online large file transfer. This is a collaboration with the ILC (<https://www.idaholidar.org/>). The GIS TReC also provides a Lidar image service (Esri REST service).

To help you learn how to access/acquire lidar data in Idaho we have developed The Idaho Lidar Web Viewer. From this web map you can learn about lidar collections and download the data to your computer. We will be demonstrating the Idaho Lidar Web Viewer at the next Elevation TWG meeting (watch your emails for that announcement).

In addition, our next TECH Talk webinar will focus on the Idaho Lidar Web Viewer and Globus Online. If you would like to be added to the announcements list for our TECH talks be sure to email me (webekeit@isu.edu).

The Payette Basin project has arrived and is currently being prepared for upload to our servers. I anticipate these data will be available by the end of next week. Similarly, an updated image service will be available with these data by the end of February.
