I have some updates and news for you regarding Lidar in Idaho. First, our lidar workshop on Friday August 7th has filled. This is good news as clearly demonstrates to me the interest in using Lidar here in Idaho!

Second, we have a new web map that is ready for review by you. It is the Proposed Lidar Collection Areas web map and you can access it by visiting https://giscenter.isu.edu/research/Techpg/FEMA_DOS/index.htm Just click the thumbnail to get started. I am interested to hear your thoughts and feedback on this map. I am considering adding a non-editable "existing lidar areas" layer to this map and am also thinking having a "vote-up" capability might be very nice. Let me know your thoughts on this.

Third, based on the reports I have seen, collection for new lidar areas is still underway and we will likely see a deluge of new data pouring in later this year and throughout 2021. We will make these data available as quickly as possible.
